This letter is in final response to the above-referenced request for information you sent to the Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552. You requested the following:

[A]n electronic copy of all correspondence between CEQ and the Idaho Panhandle National Forest (IPNF) on the Grizzly Fire Salvage and Restoration Project.
